

## RISK ASSESSMENT FOR: NIGHTLINES.

**Managing risk:** Instructors will hold the appropriate qualification for the activity, where one exists. (*ref. Lagganlia Standard Operation Procedures*). Senior Lagganlia staff will be satisfied that instructors are trained and competent to lead the activity, and instructors are familiar with standard operating procedures for the centre.

**Who is at risk:** All participants and other site users.

Collision with trees and branches	Likely Serious	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Vigilance from the instructor monitoring students.</li><li>• High risk areas highlighted to group, and managed effectively.</li><li>• Goggles worn</li><li>• Helmets worn</li><li>• Staff leaders carry torches</li><li>• Full body cover worn</li></ul>	Low
Group members getting separated	Likely Minor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Group members remain in contact with each other ( hand on shoulder)</li><li>• Count numbers out and in</li><li>• Operate in small teams where possible.</li><li>• Approved nightline site used</li><li>• Staff leaders carry torches</li></ul>	Low
